## **Embryo Grading**

You are invited to participate in an interactive educational webinar on embryo grading, hosted by the IETS Foundation. The webinar will cover IVP and IVD embryos.

Dr. Jennifer Barfield completed a bachelor's degree in animal science from North Carolina State University in 2000. She then completed a PhD in conservation biology at the University of New Orleans, where she studied potassium channels on sperm as potential targets for a non-hormonal male contraceptive. This work was completed in partnership with the University of Muenster,



Germany. Following her PhD, Barfield completed a postdoc at Colorado State University and then spent 6 months at the USDA's National Animal Germplasm Program, followed by 2 months at the New Bolton Center at the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Barfield returned to Colorado State University as a faculty member in 2011. She is currently an assistant professor in the Department of Biomedical Sciences where her research focuses on assisted reproduction primarily in bison and cattle. She also co-founded a professional master's program in assisted reproductive technologies, which began in August 2013. Her bison research significantly contributed to the establishment of the Laramie Foothills Bison Conservation Herd in northern Colorado, which she continues to manage.
